WHAT IS A DILDO?

A **dildo** is a sex toy made to be inserted in the vagina, anus, or mouth. A dildo can be used in solo or partnered play, and is not limited to any genders, body types, and experience levels.

Dildos can be phallic shaped, but many are not! Dildos come in a large variety of a penis, but not always! They come in a vast variety of shapes, sizes, colors, and designs.

Although dildos are typically associated with penetrative sex, penetration is not necessary! Keep reading this zine to learn more about different ways to use one.



HOW TO:

Besides penetration, how can I use a dildo?

- Use it to externally stimulate the anus
- Sit on it
- Use to practice oral sex or deepthroating
- Strap into a harness
- Hold it! Dildos can be great fidget toys
- Use it for double penetration
- Suction to the floor and ride it
- Tease yourself or a partner with it!
- Suck on it

Silicone, not to be used with silicone lube


SLIMLINE DILDO

Suction base



P-SPOT, G-SPOT, A-SPOT



The P-spot, formally known as the prostate, is a lot like the G-spot, but in people with penises. This walnut-sized gland sits about 2 inches inside the anus between the penis and bladder, and can be accessed with fingers, a penis, or a dildo.



The G-spot is part of the internal clitoral network and is located about 2 inches inside the vagina on the front wall. You can reach the G-spot with a penis, fingers, or a dildo!

The A-spot, AKA the anterior fornix, is located deep inside (about 6 inches) the vagina between the bladder and cervix. It's sometimes referred to as the deep spot because it's harder to reach compared to the G-spot.

- Lube! Water-based lube will work with any dildo, silicone or hybrid lube can be used with non-silicone dildos *only*.
- If using a harness, make sure it's comfortable and properly sized to your body!
- Take your time—learning how you enjoy (or don't!) using a dildo can be a long process, be patient with yourself
- Choose your own depth
Keep your dildos clean! *Pure* silicone toys can be boiled, otherwise cleaning spray or soap and water will suffice!
- Keep your dildo in a dry, cool, place to preserve it!

TIPS

“THERE’S A DILDO FOR THAT”: BENEFITS TO DILDOS

While a dildo can pleasure someone in similar ways to a penis, it also has some unique perks:

- A dildo can be gender-affirming!
- It stays erect (no refractory period or breaks needed, unless you want to!)
- You can choose the density and firmness: soft and squishy, rigid and firm, -- it's all up to you.
- You can pick whatever kind you're interested in: hyper realistic and veiny with balls? Or a fantasy dildo? The choice is yours.
- You choose the size: slender, girthy, short, long, whatever you want!
- No risk of pregnancy

Size	Materials	Types
Length and Reach	Silicone (Classic, easy to clean), Vibrating, Thrusting, Rotating, Remote-Controlled	
Width and Stretch	Glass (heat conductor!), Dual-Density	
Curved (for G-spot or P-spot)	Stainless Steel (heat conductor!)	Squirting Dildo
